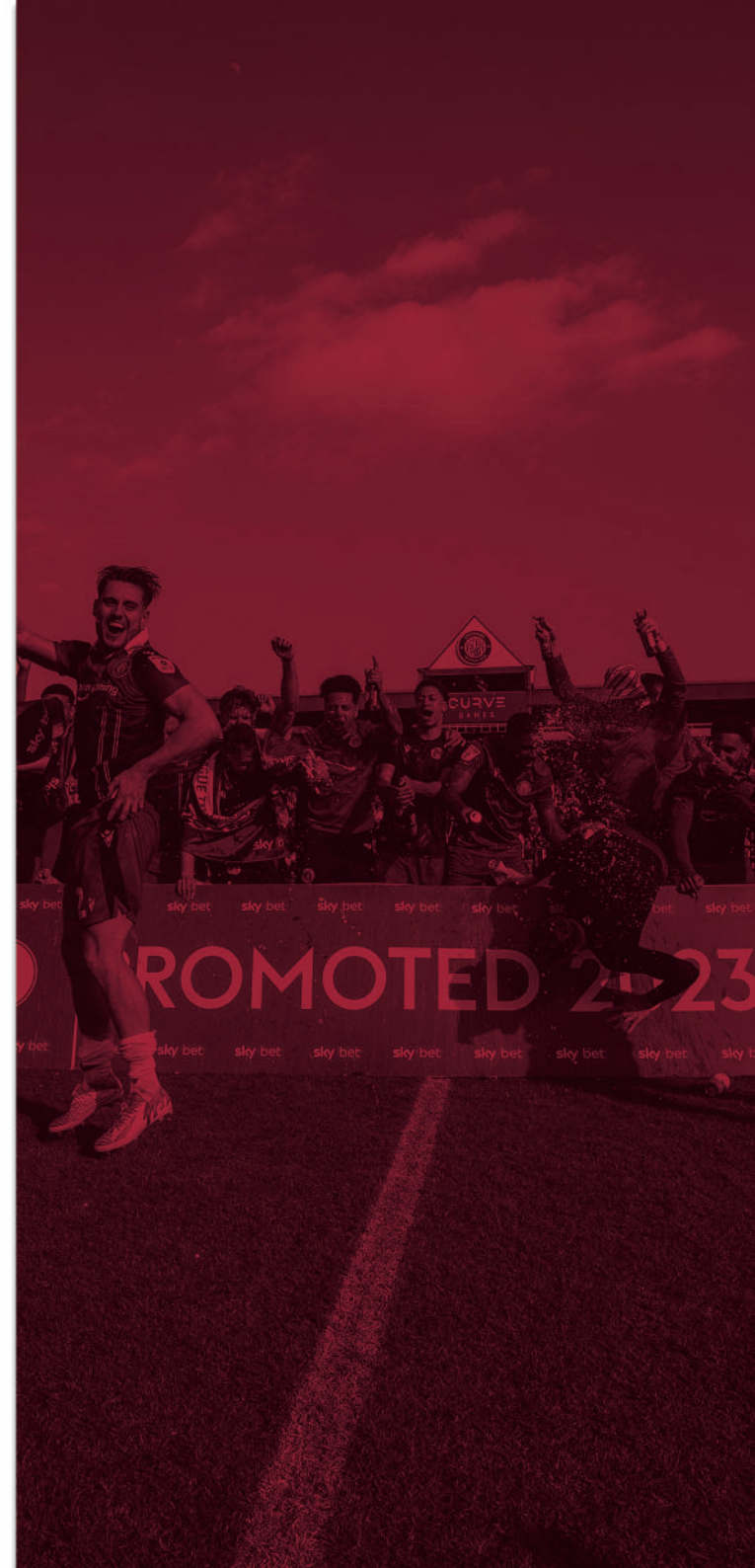

A Brief History



Stevenage Football Club has continued to make waves in the world of football since its formation in **1976**.

The club was formed as **Stevenage Borough** following the bankruptcy of **Stevenage Athletic** and after spending the first decade and a half of the clubs history moving up and down the Isthmian League's, promotion to the **Football Conference** was finally confirmed in **1994**.

Despite winning the league just two seasons later, inadequate ground facilities meant promotion was denied. 14 years later, justice was finally served as a record breaking Conference title winning campaign saw the club become a **Football League** side for the first time in the club's history in **2010**.

Promotion to **League One** soon followed where the club spent three seasons in the third tier of English Football before re-joining **League Two** in 2014.

Stevenage returned to League One in 2023 after finishing as runners-up under the guidance of Steve Evans.



Tickets

How to Buy

Stevenage FC offers three ways to buy your match ticket:

Online

Online tickets offer supporters an **easier** means of purchasing matchday tickets.

Either print at home or use your mobile device to scan your ticket on our digital turnstiles.

From the Club Shop

Open **Mondays, Tuesdays & Fridays** (10am-5pm) and **home matchdays** (Midday - Kick-Off, *inc. THFC U21s fixtures*).

From the Ticket Office

On the day of a **Saturday home game** (Midday - Kick-Off), and when we have a **Tuesday home game** (6pm - Kick-Off).

This is also where tickets bought online for collection can be collected from.

Which Stand?

With three seated stands and one standing terrace, find out what part of the stadium is perfect for you.

North Stand

At the beginning of the 2017/2018 season, Stevenage fans raised over £600,000 in crowdfunding to be used to build a new, state-of-the-art North Stand on Broadhall Way.

The North Stand brings a unique viewpoint of The Lamex Stadium pitch for Stevenage supporters, complete with an inside concourse that features warmth, food, drink, toilet facilities and mounted televisions.

West Stand

Our West Stand is an all seater stand that holds 2,000 fans, as well as housing our hospitality areas, press boxes and the tunnel leading to the changing rooms. These seats offer a great view and are perfect to bring your youngsters along for the first time.

East Terrace

The best atmosphere at The Lamex comes from the East Terrace, which is a standing only stand. Our most vocal fans who lead the singing, dancing and banging on the drums are housed in the centre of this, but standing anywhere on the terrace guarantees a unique experience.

South Stand

Our 1,500 capacity South Stand is allocated to visiting fans. With the opposition usually kicking towards this end in the second half, it creates a great atmosphere between the two sets of fans.

Disabled/Wheelchair Tickets

Home supporters who require wheelchair access at The Lamex Stadium are advised to purchase tickets for the disabled sections in the North Stand, while away supporters must purchase tickets for the South (Away) Stand.

There are 14 disabled spaces available in the North Stand, with eight in the raised West section accessed through Exit 8 and six in the lower east section accesses through Exit 9. In the South (Away) Stand, there are four disabled places with carer alongside, accessible through Exit 4A.

Disabled supporters can request a parking space at The Lamex Stadium by filling in this form (Disabled Supporter Parking Registration Form), and there is also a free car park on the opposite side of the road at Fairlands Valley, which is fully accessible via the underpass.

Fans requiring tickets for the wheelchair section can call 01438 223 223 and will be required to pay the relevant age concession with a free carer.

Ambulant Disabled

Ambulant disabled fans (medium/high-rate disability allowance) can purchase tickets for any chosen stand at the normal concession price with a free carer/personal assistant as required, if they can get to and from their seat without difficulty.

Where there is a need to sit in a specific seat i.e., on the end of a row or where there are few or no steps, then please contact DSLO at dslo@stevenagefc.com.

Audio Commentary

For supporters with a visual impairment, we have a dedicated commentary service where you can borrow a receiver to listen to live match commentary. Please contact DSLO to pre-book the equipment as soon as possible.

Guide Dogs

Guide dogs are admitted to all areas of the Stadium with visually impaired supporters.

Directions to The Lamex Stadium

Car

Directions are signposted from Junction 7 on the A1 (M). Please use the underpass to cross the A602. Do not cross the dual carriageway. **Free matchday parking** for 500 cars is available to fans at Fairlands Valley Car Park, to the North of the ground.

Train

Stevenage train station is mainly served by **LNER, Great Northern & Thameslink** trains. LNER trains connect Leeds to Stevenage in 1h 57m, while both Great Northern & Thameslink run from Cambridge to Stevenage (40m) & London Kings Cross to Stevenage (43m).

To walk from Stevenage train station to The Lamex Stadium, cross over the bridge towards the Gordon Craig theatre. Walk through the tunnel and continue before turning right once you reach the town square. Then continue through the town before going under the underpass at ASDA.

From ASDA, continue walking on the pavement down the dual carriageway, past McDonalds and the Roaring Meg retail park.

The Lamex Stadium is then viewable on the corner of the roundabout. Please use the underpasses on Broadhall Way to complete your Journey.

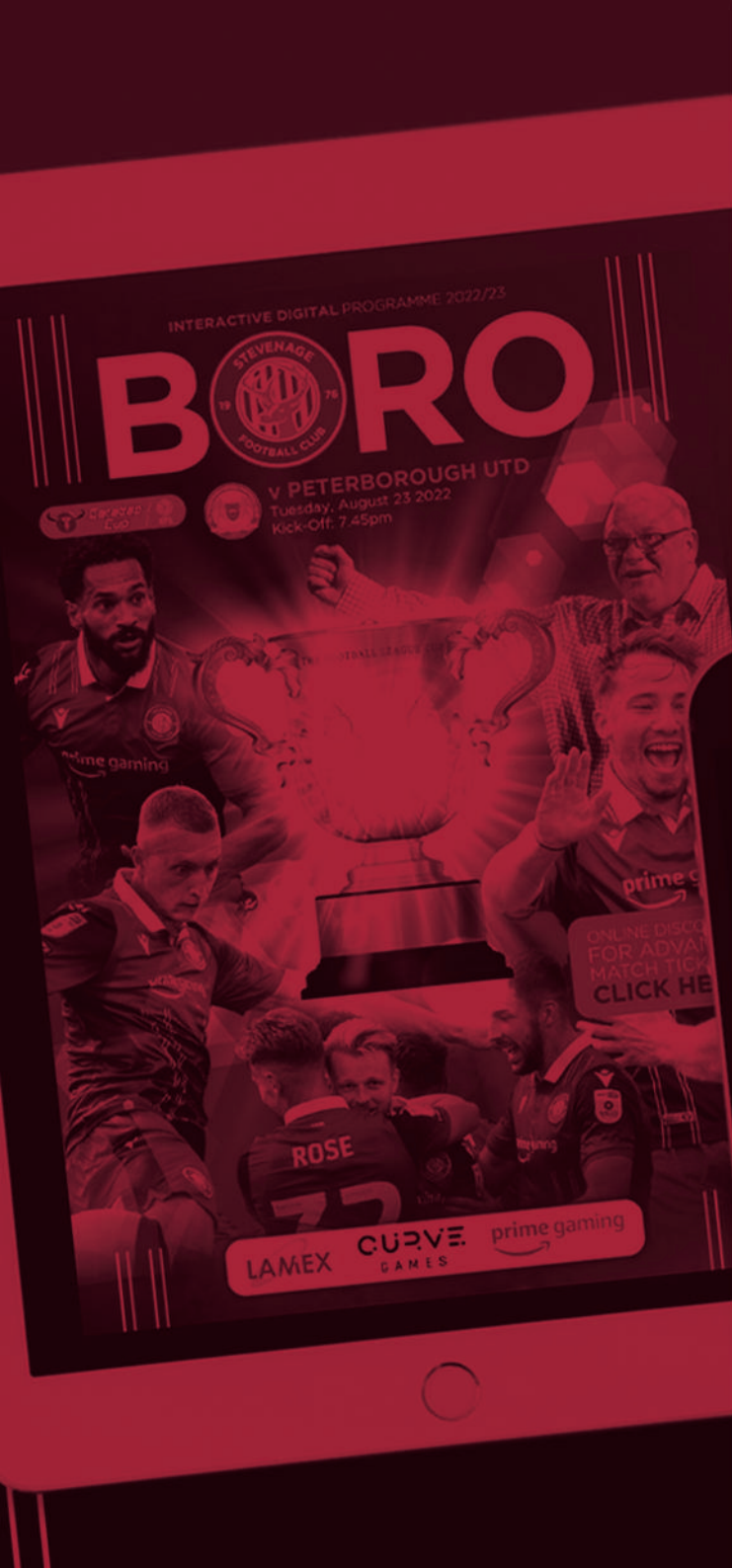
Free, Digital & Interactive
